

Information for Parents/Carers on the Re-Opening of Archbishop Beck Catholic College, September, 2020.

Following Guidance from the Department for Education

This information will be updated regularly as further guidance is provided nationally.

Our priority at Archbishop Beck Catholic College is to ensure that all students and staff are safe

1. Return dates for students

There will be a phased return for students in September, 2020, as follows:

- Tuesday/ Wednesday, 1st and 2nd September – INSET Days for staff
- Thursday, 3rd September
 - Year 7 only - 8.30am - 12pm
 - Year 8 and 9 - 1pm – 2.45pm
- Friday, 4th September
 - Year 7 only - 8.30am - 12pm
 - Year 10 and 11 - 1pm – 2.45pm

 - Year 13 - 9.00 - 10.30am
 - Year 12 - 11.00 – 12.30pm
- Monday, 7th September – Years 7, 10, 11 and 12 (All day)
- Tuesday, 8th September – All students (normal college day)

Please try to encourage students to arrive on time, and not too early, to help with us supervising entry to College.

- #### 2. Students are to be in full College uniform.
- PE kit is not required in the first few weeks

3. There will be no hot meals due to the limitations of our dining facilities. Can I encourage students to bring their own packed lunch.
Packed lunches will be available for children who receive free school meals and will be available to purchase each day for other students at a cost of £2.00. Students will order their packed lunch, if required, during form time.
4. There will be no breakfast club and no food available at break time to purchase.
5. Can students please bring their own equipment, including, pens, pencils, rulers etc. Pencil cases, with equipment, are available to purchase from the College for £1.50. Students also need to bring their own calculator as we will be unable to give them out.
6. Students are allowed to wear masks during the College day.
7. Can I remind you that students are not allowed to use their mobile phones during the College day. Persistent offenders will be banned from bringing their mobile phones into the College.
8. Parents will not be allowed to enter the College site (including in cars) so students will need to be dropped off outside the College gates.
9. Students will be taught in a year group 'bubble'. This means that they will remain in the same classroom area for all their lessons (for example, a year group will be based in the English suite of rooms throughout the day). Students will be given designated entrance points to the College to ensure social distancing.
