What type of assessment will I be doing?	<p>Foundation</p> <p>The students will be completing 3 mock examination papers that have been set by the examination board, the papers will cover all aspects of the course.</p> <p>The examination paper will be sat in examination conditions to prepare the students fully for their experience in their summer GCSE examinations.</p> <p>Higher</p> <p>The students will be completing adapted examination papers that have been set by the examination board, the papers will cover many aspects of the course and you will be given a revision list to help prepare you.</p> <p>The examination paper will be sat in mock examination conditions to prepare the students fully for their experience in their summer GCSE examinations.</p>
What topics do I need to prepare for?	<p>The examination will be a 3 x60minute papers, paper 1 will be non-calculator, paper 2 and 3 both calculator papers.</p> <p>Foundation – About 50 per cent of the marks assess number, ratio, proportion and rates of change. Around 20 per cent of the marks assess algebra skills and 30 per cent assess geometry &amp; measure and probability and statistics.</p> <p>Higher - About 35 per cent of the marks assess number, ratio, proportion and rates of change. Around 30 per cent of the marks assess algebra skills and 35 per cent assess geometry &amp; measure and probability and statistics.</p>
